

SINGLE TAX IS NOT TAX EXEMPTION!

The Toronto Board of Trade, the Canadian Manufacturers' Association (Toronto branch) and The Retail Merchants' Association of Canada (Toronto branch), recommend to the favorable consideration of the ratepayers—especially the 90,000 home-owners now enjoying tax exemption—the Report of the Special Committee appointed by the City Council to study the proposed by-law.

This Report, which was unanimously accepted and endorsed by the *City Council*, recommended as follows:

- 1 The proposition is economically unsound and would have a disastrous effect upon the raising of revenue for city purposes.
- 2 Many millions of wealth now paying a fair share of taxes toward the maintenance of civic institutions would escape taxation.
- 3 The proposition is unjust, inequitable and unworkable.
- 4 The proposition, wherever applied in Canada at least, has proven a failure and municipalities have been forced to revert to a wider basis of taxation.
